

## WHAT IS DISABILITY RIGHTS NEW YORK?

Disability Rights New York (DRNY) is the Protection & Advocacy System and Client Assistance Program (P&A/CAP) for persons with disabilities in New York. As the P&A/CAP for New York, DRNY advocates for the civil and legal rights of New Yorkers with disabilities.

New York residents with disabilities can contact DRNY for assistance with problems directly related to their disabilities. DRNY investigates complaints and provides direct assistance to people with disability-related issues under the terms of its federal grants and its annual goals and priorities. DRNY administers the following grant-based programs:

**PADD** – Protection and Advocacy for Individuals with Developmental Disabilities

**PAIMI** – Protection and Advocacy for Individuals with Mental Illness

**PAIR** – Protection and Advocacy for Individual Rights

**PAAT** – Protection and Advocacy for Assistive Technology

**CAP** – Client Assistance Program

**PAVA** – Protection and Advocacy for Voter Access

**PATBI** – Protection and Advocacy for Individuals with Traumatic Brain Injuries

**PABSS** – Protection and Advocacy for Beneficiaries of Social Security
